



Temporary Disruption

affecting bus service 359

Thursday 16 October to Monday 10 November 2025

Two road closures will take place on the B3212 near Doccombe between 16 October and 10 November 2025. Through journeys on service 359 between Exeter and Moretonhampstead will operate on diversion via the A30 during these works.

Devon County Council have organised for a shuttle service to operate between Dunsford and Exeter via Longdown. This will operate 3 journeys in each direction, Monday to Saturday.

In addition, a replacement taxi service has been organised between Doccombe and Moretonhampstead. This will be operated by Alansway Taxis. Those wishing to use the taxi should pre-book at least one day before travel on **01626 334477**.
